

# Cabinet Savers Size Information and Installation Instructions

## Cabinet Savers Size Ordering Instructions

### Existing Cabinets:

Measure cabinet's inside dimensions, order from the chart below based on the Cabinet Savers Actual Size.

*Note: the Depth of the Cabinet Savers can be adjusted by trimming the front lip with a utility knife.*

### New Cabinets:

Order based on Cabinet Size from the chart below.

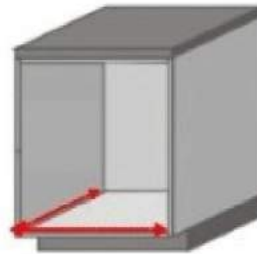
*Note: new cabinets are sized to the outside dimensions.*

18" x 16"	16½"W x 14½" to 16"D x 1¼"H	1 Quart of Liquid
24" x 18"	22"W x 16 to 17½"D x 1¼"H	1.3 Quarts of Liquid
24" x 21"	22"W x 19½ to 20½"D x 1¼"H	1.6 Quarts of Liquid
30" x 21"	28"W x 19½ to 20½"D x 1¼"H	2.8 Quarts of Liquid
36" x 21"	34"W x 19½ to 20½"D x 1¼"H	3.6 Quarts of Liquid
24" x 24"	22"W x 22 to 23½"D x 1¼"H	2.3 Quarts of Liquid
27" x 24"	25"W x 22 to 23½"D x 1¼"H	2.6 Quarts of Liquid
30" x 24"	28"W x 22 to 23½"D x 1¼"H	3.1 Quarts of Liquid
33" x 24"	31"W x 22 to 23½"D x 1¼"H	3.4 Quarts of Liquid
36" x 24"	34"W x 22 to 23½"D x 1¼"H	4.1 Quarts of Liquid

\*\*All Sides are 1.75" high except front lip\*\*

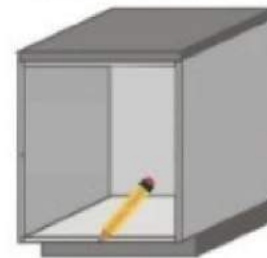


### Measure Depth: Inside Back To Front

Mark drain hole position on cabinet, drill 3/8" hole for drain cone. Cut tip off drain cone.

Then slide the Cabinet Savers into the cabinet with the drain cone in the hole.
